We'd hoped to issue this letter in January but the annual nightmare of sorting out dates presented itself and whilst not 100% resolved felt that the sooner we publish what we have the better.

What's new for 2010, well firstly Chris is back in part time education, the fruits of his continuing labours being a website devoted entirely to the Wessex Aeromodellers League www.wessexaml.co.uk This site will of course have dates details etc of happenings along with links to other aeromodelling areas. The Low-Cost 600RES electric glider and Tomboy events will be confined to 5 meetings each.

The events for 2010 will be: -

600RES (Low-cost Electric glider)

Tomboy (Power event using a Mills 75/MP Jet 040/Mills 1.3)

Power duration (Three classes)

Mini speed (Trainer model with 1.5 diesel)

Apart from the website there are two new events.

1. Control line. This is a mini speed competition using what is basically a training model with a 1.5cc diesel. (See website). Venues for flying CL are few and far between however with 2 meets at Wimborne Club – Cashmoor and three at Middle Wallop there is an opportunity to join in or at least watch. How many aeromodellers didn't have a go at CL years ago? A plan is available to download on the website.
2. Power duration. Bill Longley is, through his company Tasma, running three classes of power duration competitions to be flown along side some of the Tomboy comps and also at Middle Wallop. Models are FF power models mainly from the 50's with RC control. Again see website for more details.

The 600RES Low-Cost class will continue as last year as will the two Tomboy classes.

Remember if you don't want to join in but are intrigued you are welcome to come along and spectate. The events are run along side the host club members who will be sport flying, this to date has worked out very well providing interest and involvement in two directions. Events held at Cashmoor will include a BBQ and ladies WC. Salisbury Club also has great facilities and WC's.
